Materials

Lesson Plan

I. Introductory Discussion

- A. Indicate that this lesson will introduce students to five ways to be successful learners and happy people.
- B. Ask students to reflect upon the "inside" qualities that make them successful and happy. Write on the board "Successful and happy."
- C. Distribute the "Powering Your Way to Success" Student Worksheet.
- D. Describe the five different kinds of fuel represented in the "Powering Your Way to Success" Student Worksheet. Explain that these are the five qualities of successful learners that are called the "5 Keys to Success and Happiness."

II. Small Group Activity – "Chemical Compound Analysis"

- A. Divide your class into small groups of between four and six students. Distribute one of the "Chemical Compound Analysis" signs to each group.
- B. Ask each group to subject their particular compound to an analysis of its essential elements. That is, ask students to define the meanings of each of the 5 Foundations and to provide examples of the compound's behavior as well as any attitudes or thoughts that are constituent elements of the compound.
- C. Have a representative from each group summarize the results of their analysis.
- D. Distribute the "Analysis of the 5 Keys for Success and Happiness" Student Worksheet. Instruct each group to use the worksheet to gather the information they need to include in their report.


III. Individual Student Activity – "Keys for Success and Happiness Self-Analysis"

- A. Distribute the "Keys for Success" Student Form.
- B. Instruct students how to complete the worksheet. You may read aloud the 20 questions. Have students complete.

Lesson 1: Mission: Success and Happiness



Lesson Objectives

- 1 Students will be able to define the meaning of "success" and "happiness."
- 2 Students will be able to describe the "internal" and "external" positive consequences of being successful.
- 3 Students will be able to judge their own successes in terms of the extent to which they have accomplished their own personal goals rather than by comparing their accomplishments to other students' accomplishments.
- 4 Students will be able to explain that one of the main purposes of Program Achieve is to teach students how to be successful and happy.



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
